NATURE

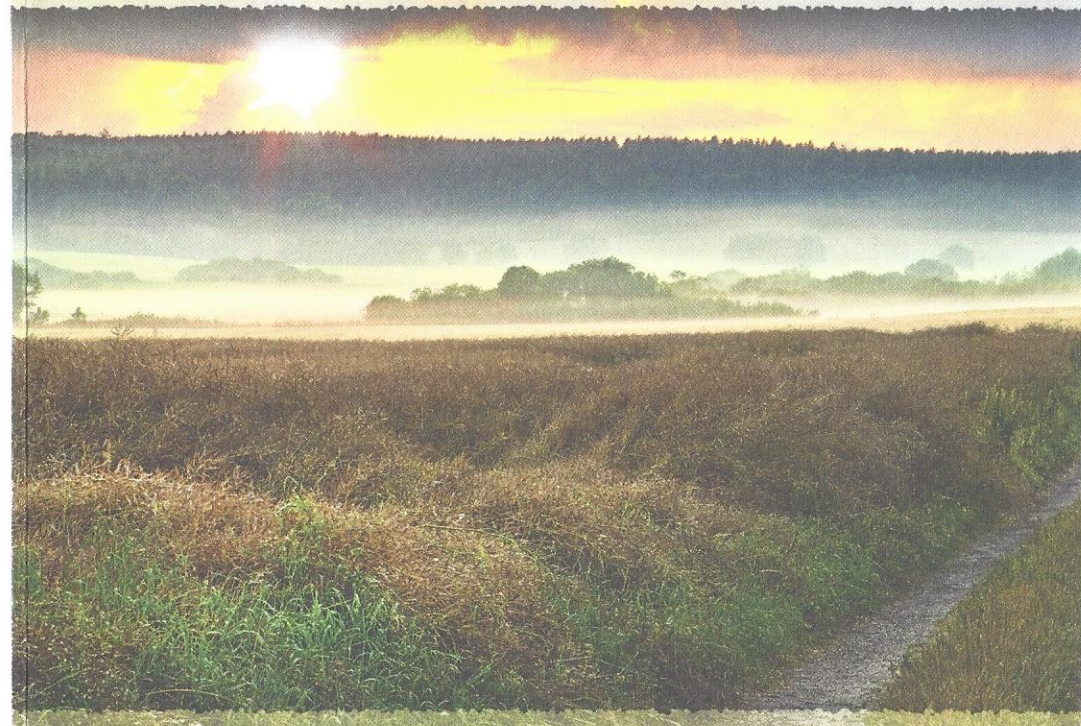
