But we all have the choice more, a duty to battle freedoms' foe.

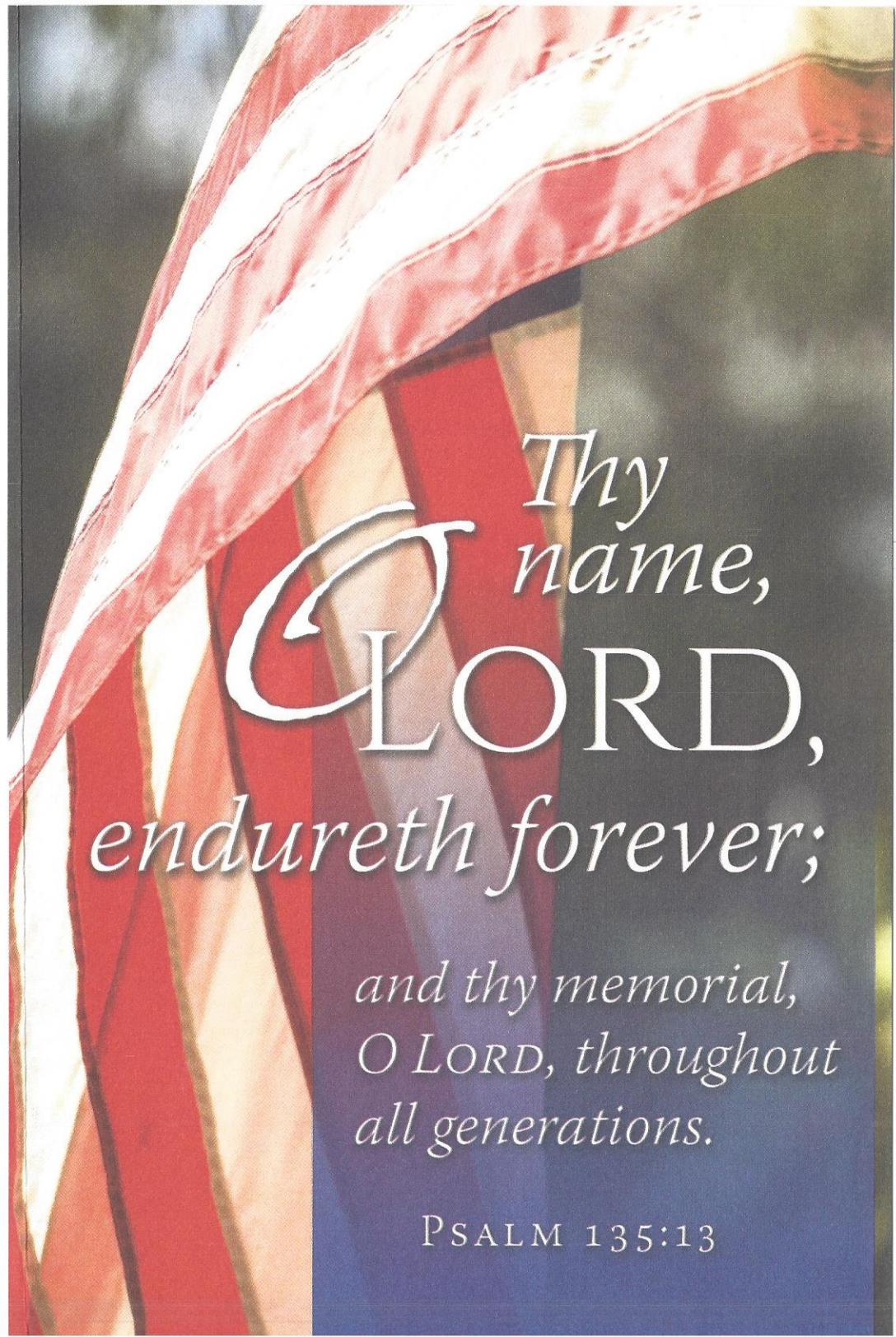
Let us give thanks this day to all those brave who paid the highest cost.
