“Trust not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart upon them.” Psalm 62:10

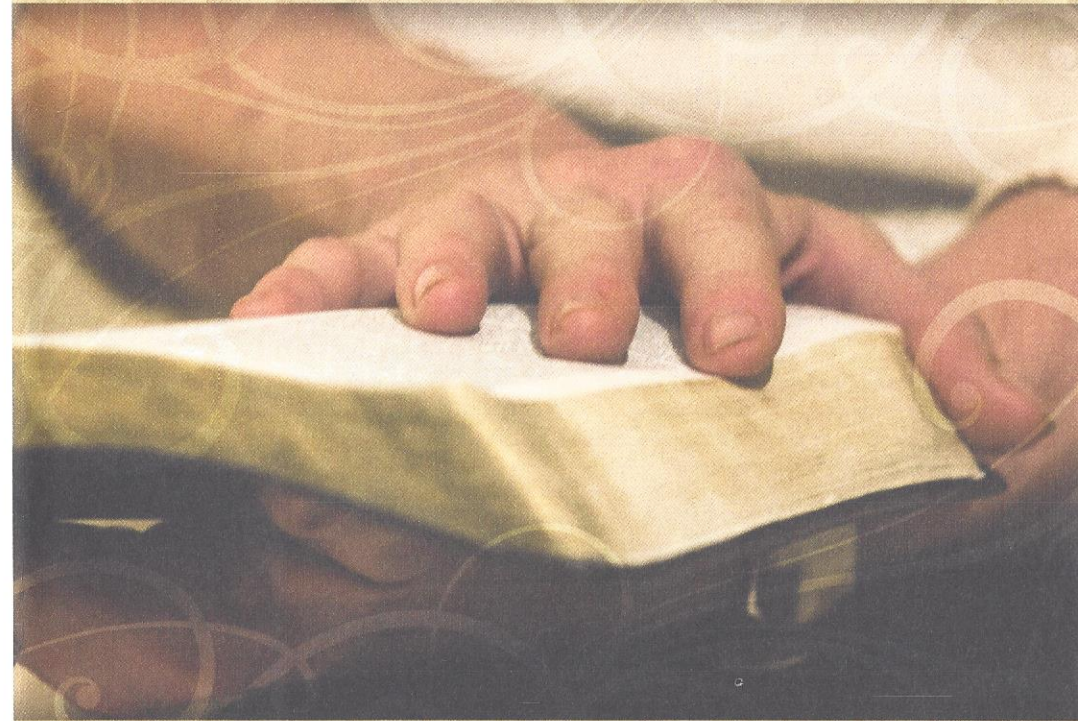
