**HOW GOD BUILDS**

Devotion Passage: Nehemiah 4:1-14

Key Verse:

*“So build we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work.”  
Nehemiah 4:6*

We can learn a lot from Nehemiah: how to analyze a difficult problem and craft a solution, how to stay true to our conviction and vision in the face of opposition, how to organize and motivate people around a common cause, and how to stay with a task until it’s complete. But most importantly, we learn how God builds. Although the context of the passage is very different from our context, it is clear that the message of the text is indeed very relevant to us as a congregation of people in the twenty-first century.

The dynamic we see in the verse today is how the church cannot just survive in difficult times, but in how the church can actually thrive if we will just work together. The church requires many skills: crafty and creative, skilled with a hammer or with a piano, bold leaders and quiet workers, folks in the front charging ahead, and those in the background doing the work that is essential, but often unseen.

**Today, ask yourself, Am I doing my part?**

Father, as we plan, think, manage, create, and try to motivate people for ministry, remind us that ultimately success depends on You.
